GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show will be run under the rules of SAEF, DSA, EQSA, SASA & the Border Equestrian Club and all relevant rules and regulations apply.
2. The SAEF, DSA, SASA & SASJ levies have been included in the entry fee and are detailed in the schedule.
3. Results at this show, for graded classes, will count for grading points, subject to the approval of the relevant SAEF Official.
4. All riders to wear protective headgear on the show grounds. Children & Juniors to wear correct restraining harness on hat as stated in rule 12.2.2.
5. SAEF, DSA, SASJ, SASA, BEC, ELAAIS and Show Organisers will not accept responsibility for any loss of property, damage or injury sustained by owners, competitors and members of the public or any other person or their property at Border Equestrian Club for the duration of the Show.
6. **The owner of any dog not on a leash will be fined.**
7. No late entries or entries without proof of payment will be accepted. Entries without valid flu and AHS details won't be accepted.
8. It is the competitor's responsibility to check whether their entries have been received.
9. This is a multi-discipline show and we will make all efforts to make sure classes don't clash, but if it is impossible competitors will have to choose which classes they will be competing in.
10. **No refund will be given after closing date of entries if a competitor scratches for whatever reason. If you have entered this show, and scratch your entry after closing date, you will still be liable to pay your fees.**
11. By entering a stallion at the BEC, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
 - a. Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - b. It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - c. The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
 - d. Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the BEC premises
 - e. All stallions must wear a yellow tag on their bridles at all times
12. For each RIDER riding more than 3 horses, every 4th horse is exempt from the horse levy. This is applicable to "Horses per RIDER", not "Horses per Stable yard or per Owner" if ridden by different riders. If one of the horses is ridden by a Riders' child and the child is under 18 years old, this will count as a horse for the main rider and therefore towards the free horse fee.
- Please contact the BEC if you feel that you should qualify for this free horse discount.
13. FREE STABLING is offered to any out of town riders: 150km and more. Please contact Joanna should you feel that you fall into this category.
14. Junior and Adult classes may be combined if entries are insufficient to hold the classes individually. In showing & dressage classes, separate prizes will be awarded for Juniors and Adults. Please be sure to check times once the final program is out.
15. The program appearing in this schedule is STRICTLY PROVISIONAL and may change once all entries are received. Competitors are urged not to enter classes based purely on provisional program times.
16. Prize money awarded will only be done so for GRADED classes, and only if entries cover the costs of the show.
17. Any entry fees for classes include the following levies:
 - a. SHOW JUMPING: SASJ Levy (Recreational - R15.00; Pony Rider and Junior R40; Adult 90cm – 1.25m R40, Adult 1.30 upwards R60) and R5.13 EDTS Levy per class,
 - b. DRESSAGE: Graded Classes: R57.50 & EDTS Levy of R4.50
Recreational Classes: R23.00 & EDTS Levy of R4.50
 - c. EQUITATION: Graded Classes: SAEQA levies of R30-00 & EDTS of R4.50

*2 classes may be entered per day. Please ensure you are riding in your correct grade.

CLASS RULES: Welcome Stakes: FEI ART Competition in 2 Phases: FEI ART 274.1.5.2; A2 FEI ART: 238.2.1; Accumulator: FEI ART 269; Championship FEI ART 238.2.2; Provincial Championship Classes (PR1.20m & Junior 1.30m) FEI ART 273.

Recreational, Child on a Horse, Junior and Adult classes may be combined, depending on entries.

Classes to be run HC, depending on entries

Pony Riders: 50cm- 0.80cm Recreational Welcome Stakes, A2 & Championship

0.90-1.20m Graded Welcome Stakes, A2 & Championship (1.20m PR Champs to be held over 2 Rounds)

Juniors & Adults: 50cm- 90cm Recreational Welcome Stakes, A2, & Championship

0.90-1.35m Graded Welcome Stakes, A2 & Championship

EQUITATION – THURSDAY 5TH SEPTEMBER 2019

Graded classes are affiliated to SAEF and SAEQA. SAEQA levies of R30-00 & Development fee of R4.50 included in entry fee. Ungraded Classes include SAEQA provisional levy.

Prize money will only be awarded should entries cover the costs of running the discipline.

Entry Fee: ALL TESTS ARE R160

- Only 1 test allowed **per rider: YOU MAY NOT ENTER MORE THAN 1 HORSE AT ANY SHOW**
- Please make sure the height you are jumping for your equitation test **is not higher** than your graded jumping height
